Question/Clarification of the Prospective Bidders

Terms of Reference	Who is your Primary Internet Service Provider?	PLDT is the Primary Internet Service Provider.
	It is stated under Sub-Section VII. Letter F. "The DIA, Broadband and Satellite Internet subscriptions must have at least One (1) Usable Public IP Address each." but in the Table: Secondary and Tertiary Internet Service Specifications, the Public IP provided for SWAD Malaybalay, and SWAD Camiguin are both N/A.	For SWAD Malaybalay, and SWAD Camiguin, it is stated N/A, but if you can provide an IP for that then it would be better.
	Is it necessary for the MNSP to have a physical office in Cagayan de Oro City? For instance, our company is based in Luzon, yet we are capable of delivering services nationwide.	Yes, it is required that the Managed Network Service Provider (MNSP) must have a physical office located in Cagayan de Oro City. The office should operate from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM, Monday through Friday, and must be capable of providing extended support services 24/7 to ensure timely resolution of any network-related issues, even outside regular business hours.

Is this project one lot, or can it be divided into several lots for each specific area?

This project is one (1) lot.

Can we tap third party ISP for sites that are Not Feasible to us but still we are the only provider for this project as managed service?

As stipulated under Section VII. Terms of Reference, Sub-Section I. Scope of Services, the Managed Network Service Provider (MNSP) is responsible for identifying. facilitating. and evaluating, managing reputable and distinct Internet Service Providers (ISPs) that will deliver reliable and highquality Internet services. MNSP will also act as the single point of contact for all ISPs and DSWD Field Office X. Therefore, it is acceptable to tap third-party ISPs, provided that the MNSP maintains full management responsibility and remains the primary point of contact for this project.

How many routers do you need? Is it 1 router per site? What are the specifications of the router?

At least one router is required per site. The router specifications must include, at a minimum, support for Wi-Fi 5, capability to handle Public IP assignments, and support for SD-WAN functions. The device should also be robust enough to handle the site's anticipated traffic and network demands.

Requesting if we can relax the Service Reliability of Broadband Internet from minimum of 50% subscribed speed to minimum of 30% subscribed speed?

While we acknowledge that this service will act as a Secondary ISP, we would prefer to adhere to the current requirement of 50% of the subscribed speed and 80% service reliability. The reliability of the secondary ISP is critical, as it impacts the continuity operations in DSWD offices. A reduction in speed or reliability could compromise service performance. particularly mission-critical applications.

While we recognize that Fiber Optic Cable (FOC) generally

	that area, can Internet via Starlink?		r Broadba instead	of	offers a high-quality solution where feasible, in this particular case, our preference remains with LEO Satellites. This decision is based on the specific policy and environmental factors in the areas of concern, where LEO Satellites are more suited to providing consistent and reliable coverage. Therefore, for these sites, we recommend adhering to the current plan of using LEO satellite technology.
