This Supplemental/Bid Bulletin is issued to all prospective bidders announcing the Response on the Question/Clarification of the Prospective Bidders, and the Amendments/Changes in the Bidding Documents, to wit:

Question/Clarification of the Prospective Bidders

Also, what type of project shall be used as reference for the SLCC?	<p>The Bidder's SLCC similar to the contract to be bid should have been completed within four (4) years prior to the deadline for the submission and receipt of bids.</p> <p>The projects similar to the contract to be bid are: Lot 1: Supply and Delivery of Desktops(High-end); Lot 2: Supply and delivery of Desktops(Standard); Lot 3: Supply and Delivery of Laptops; and whose value must be equivalent to at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC.</p> <p>However, bidders may submit a combination of contracts completed within the prescribed period, provided that the total value of said contracts is at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC, as follows:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. 	Are the required desktop units branded or clone units?	As specified in Section VII. Technical Specifications, Clause 16. To protect DSWD from unreliable and unproven products the following is required: b. Proposed BRAND should be Energy Star Compliant f. Manufacturers offered model should be available in the Market and should not be custom-made or made to order just to comply with the specification.
	For the laptops, is it required to have the DSWD logo?	Yes, as stated in the Technical Specifications, a DSWD Boot-up Logo must be embedded in the BIOS. This requirement applies to both laptops and desktops.
	For the desktops, may we request to relax the requirement for the USB ports from ≥4 x USB 3.0 ports to USB 2.0 ports instead?	Request to relax the USB port requirement for the desktops from ≥4 x USB 3.0 ports to USB 2.0 ports is granted , subject to the following revised specification: USB Ports: ≥2 x USB 3.0 ports and ≥2 x USB 2.0 ports, either front or back.
	Regarding the warranty for the desktop monitors, are they included in the three (3) years warranty coverage?	Yes, they are included in the three (3) years warranty coverage.
	Is it possible to include in the Technical Specifications that the	A warranty certificate issued by either the manufacturer,

	warranty certificate must be issued by the manufacturer itself, and not by a distributor or reseller?	distributor, or reseller shall be deemed acceptable.
Preparation and Submission of Technical and Financial Component Envelopes	How will the submission of documents be done if we are participating in all three (3) lots?	The submission of the Technical and Financial Component Envelopes shall be on a per lot basis.
	How many copies of the bid documents are required to be submitted for each lot?	In line with the transition to Republic Act No. 12009, bidders are required to submit only the one (1) Copy which is the Original Copy for the Technical and Financial Component Envelope for each lot, and provided that the bid shall comply with the proper sealing and marking requirements prescribed under the Bidding Documents.
